

TNCS SKIING/TUBING TRIP

TNCS will go to Massanutten Ski Resort for our annual community Ski Day on Friday, February 3. This annual trip is a lot of fun and will be well supervised by TNCS faculty. We will continue to offer tubing as well. This is a great alternative to skiing/snowboarding, especially for those who don't know how to ski. The tubing area will be well supervised by teachers. This trip is optional; however, if your child does not attend the trip, they should stay home that day. There will be no alternative activities on campus.

Permission slips must be returned to the school office on or before Friday, January 20th. On Tuesday, January 24th, guests may be invited if there is room on the buses.

- Date: Friday, February 3, 2017
- Time: Arrive to school at the normal time; we will return to school at approximately 6:15pm
- Where: Massanutten Ski Resort
- Bring: Appropriate outdoor clothing, dry clothes for the bus ride home, water bottle for the bus
- Food: Bring a bag lunch or purchase lunch at the snack bar in the lodge (burgers, pizza, etc) bring cash. Also, an additional snack/meal is recommended for the bus ride home.
