Job Description:

- Keeps appropriate and up-to-date records to include attendance reports and gradebook.
- Establishes and maintains an orderly, productive classroom environment.
- Instructs students in proper care and use of tools and equipment.
- Identifies student needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students.
- Communicates with parents on student progress.
- Participates in professional learning activities.
- Becomes familiar with and follows school and division procedures for routines and emergencies.
- Performs other duties as requested by school administration.
