



TNCS SKIING/TUBING TRIP

The TNCS Middle School will go to Massanutten Ski Resort for our annual Ski Day on Friday, February 2. This annual trip is a lot of fun and will be well supervised by TNCS faculty. We will continue to offer tubing as well. This is a great alternative to skiing/snowboarding, especially for those who don't know how to ski. The tubing area will be well supervised by teachers. This trip is optional; however, if your child does not attend the trip, they should stay home that day. There will be no alternative activities on campus.

Permission slips must be returned to the school office on or before **Wednesday, January 24th**.

- **Date:** Friday, February 2, 2018
- **Time:** Arrive to school at the normal time; we will **return to school at approximately 6:15pm**
- **Where:** Massanutten Ski Resort
- **Bring:** Appropriate outdoor clothing, dry clothes for the bus ride home, water bottle for the bus
- **Food:** Bring a bag lunch or purchase lunch at the snack bar in the lodge (burgers, pizza, etc) – bring cash. Also, an additional snack/meal is recommended for the bus ride home.

** If skiing/snowboarding: The New Community School requires beginners who are new to skiing / snowboarding to take a lesson from Massanutten's ski school. There is an \$18 fee as stated above for this lesson.

I understand that strenuous physical exertion may be required in these activities. I represent that my child has no known physical disabilities or health problems which will present any risk to his/her participation in the activities. My child and I understand that all school rules will be enforced on the trip and that students are allowed only to be on the slopes, tubing park, or at the lodge area. Any private property or other resort entertainment areas are off limits to TNCS students and their guests. All TNCS students will be required to use school-arranged transportation only. TNCS students are expected to obey ski patrol and resort rules and to ski or snowboard "within their limits".
