- READ takes place in the TNCS gymnasium.
- READ begins on Friday evening with an opening reception from 7-9pm. Sponsors and Patron ticket holders get special early entry at 6pm. The reception is catered with live music and a wine/beer bar. The reception is 21 and up only.
- On Saturday, READ is open free to the public from 10am-4pm. Starting at 2pm select artwork is discounted.
- On Sunday, artwork gets picked up and clean-up is finished.
